In 2022, Shine, the Goldsmiths' Centre's annual showcase of jewellery and silversmithing by emerging talent, will be presented both online in the Centre's Shop Talent selling platform and in a physical pop-up selling exhibition at the Goldsmiths' Centre. Participants will take part in a programme of training to prepare them to promote and sell their work in person and online. The annual Shine programme has been adapted to ensure that the Goldsmiths' Centre can continue to support the next generation of makers, and equip them with the skills that the new, post-Covid, sales environment demands.

Shine 2022 will bring together collections of work that demonstrate exceptional craftsmanship in design, jewellery, silversmithing and metalwork. Participants will be selected for their creativity, innovation, and skill. The exhibition launches the work of emerging brands and designer-makers from across the UK, in their first five years of business. To apply to participate in Shine 2022, you must be resident in the UK.

All applications will be anonymised and reviewed by the selection committee, comprising invited external industry experts, a former Shine participant and Goldsmiths' Centre staff. You will be informed of the outcome of your application on or before 28th June 2022. Up to fifteen makers will be invited to showcase a collection in Shine 2022.

Shine 2022 Training Programme

Shine 2022 will support makers to develop a range of skills that will enable them to share, promote and sell their work. In response to the current sales climate, the emphasis of the 2022 programme is on online sales and promotion. To achieve this, selected makers are expected to take part in all elements the Shine 2022 programme. This will be delivered through the sessions outlined below, with one or more follow-up sessions in the autumn/winter 2022 period.
