WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR THIS COURSE?

- You must be between 16 and 19 years old when you start the Foundation Programme
- You will be required to attend at the Goldsmiths' Centre between 9am and 5pm Monday to Friday during term time
- Ideally you will have Grades 9-4 /A-C in Mathematics and English
- Applications from individuals with non-standard qualifications are invited, provided that you can demonstrate your abilities through sketch books or 2D/3D work in your portfolio
- We recommend that you have completed work experience in a workshop
- **Your application for the Foundation Programme 2021/22 must be submitted by Sunday 9th May 2021.**

HOW DO I APPLY?

- **You must submit with your application a CV and a digital portfolio** containing any previous coursework or hobby-time activity that you feel demonstrates your ability to draw, sculpt, model or make. We will consider work in any media.
- **Your application for the Foundation Programme 2021/22 must reach us by Sunday 9th May 2021.**
- You will receive an email acknowledgment to confirm we have received your application.
- If shortlisted, you will be invited to a two-day assessment, which you will need to attend, on **Thursday 27** and **Friday 28 May 2021** from 10am until 4.30pm. You will be asked to participate in technical and creative skills exercises and will get to introduce yourself to our tutors. This is so we can evaluate your problem-solving skills and artistic ability whilst also allowing you to demonstrate your accuracy and willingness to learn. Please let us know when you submit your application if you are unable to make these dates.
