

The Goldsmiths' Centre Foundation Programme 2023/2024 – Application Guidelines

What are the entry requirements for this course?

The Foundation Programme is designed to support students between 16-19 years of age/. The Goldsmiths' Centre welcomes applications outside of this age range, however, all applicants must be able to adhere to the following application criteria:

- You will be required to attend the Goldsmiths' Centre between 9am and 5pm Monday to Friday during term time
- Ideally you will have GCSE Grades 9-4 /A-C in Mathematics and English
- Applications with non-standard qualifications are invited provided that you can demonstrate your abilities through sketch books or 2D/3D work in your portfolio
- We recommend that you have completed work experience in a workshop

How to apply?

- Please complete the application form via Survey Monkey. A link will be shared on 6th December 2022 via email and via our website <u>www.goldsmiths-</u> <u>centre.org/courses/foundation-programme</u>
- You will need to complete all sections of the application form and upload your CV and portfolio.
- It is very important to note, that once you start the application via Survey Monkey, you will need to complete it. You will not be able to start the application and go back to it later. For this reason, a <u>sample application</u> <u>form</u> is included below on page 3 so that you can prepare your application prior to starting the application form via Survey Monkey.
- If you are experiencing financial hardship, you may be eligible for the Goldsmiths' Centre's Grants, which cover any financial need necessary for your continued participation on the course, such as transport costs or accommodation. Please indicate this at the relevant section of the application form.



- Your application for the Foundation Programme 2023/24 must reach us by 10pm on Sunday 30th April 2023.
- As spaces are limited to 10 Foundation Programme trainees per year, once applications open on 6th December 2022, we recommend that you submit your application as early as you can.
- You will receive an email to confirm we have received your application.
- You will also receive a link to an online Equity, Diversity and Inclusivity form (EDI). This form is anonymous, and you must complete this for your application to be considered. This helps to support the Goldsmiths' Centre's EDI strategy see www.goldsmiths-centre.org/about-us/equity-diversity-and-inclusion

If shortlisted, you will be required to attend a one-day assessment, which will take place at the Goldsmiths' Centre* (42 Britton Street, London EC1M 5AD) on Monday 23rd or Tuesday 24th May 2023 from 10am until 4.30pm.

You will be asked to participate in technical and creative skills exercises and will get to introduce yourself to some of our tutors. This is so we can evaluate your problemsolving skills and artistic ability whilst also allowing you to demonstrate your accuracy and willingness to learn. When you submit your application, please let us know which of the two dates is more convenient for you and we will do our utmost to honour your request.

*The venue for the Foundation Programme two-day assessment interviews is subject to change. These may be conducted online pending COVID-19 guidelines.
